Take a look at the picture below: Why does this dog have a suitcase? Where is it traveling, and what will it do when it gets there? Write a story that answers some of these questions. You are welcome to submit artwork with your story! Maximum length: 10 pages or 300 words	Write a story about a character who discovers a magical creature and takes it home with them. What kind of creature do they find? What happens when they try to keep it in their home? Maximum length: 750 words	Write a story about characters who are in an old building, riding an elevator that suddenly stops between floors and opens to a place that shouldn't exist. Where are they, and how do they get out? Maximum length: 1,500 words
